

Ho Chunk Sports Complex Facility Rules

The Ho Chunk Sports Complex is a privately funded sports facility. All Ho Chunk Sports Complex staff are paid employees, not volunteers. We get no financial revenues from any governmental taxing body. In order to provide the event participants the highest quality event possible, we must be fiscally responsible and have to rely on the revenues generated through our gate fees, concession sales & vendor agreements. We graciously ask for your support in our efforts to provide the highest quality events we possibly can.

- 1) Be aware and cautious of foul balls. There are ample covered seating areas provided for fans to watch the games.
- 2) Under no circumstances will any pets, coolers, food or alcohol be allowed.
- 3) Admission charge is \$5.00 per adult per day. \$2.00 for senior citizens & kids 7 & older. Admission fees are non-refundable.
- 4) Players must wear protective head gear when using batting cages and must be accompanied by adult coach.
- 5) Coaches and players use cages at their own risk.
- 6) No warming-up in the outfield grass wearing metal spikes until game time. EXCEPTION: All players wearing tennis shoes while warming-up before the game begins.
- 7) No Flip drills anywhere on the field before game time.
- 8) There are ample batting cages and warm-up areas throughout the facility to warm-up. Batting cages and open areas
- 9) Groundballs and playing catch are allowed in the warning track areas.
- 10) These rules will be strictly enforced as these rules help limit the overall wear and tear our fields undergo as a result of the numerous games being played on them each season.
- 11) Teams must clean the dugouts after the completion of their game. Please be courteous to the team following you.
- 12) There are full service washrooms in the concession building. In addition there are satellite portable washrooms.
- 13) There is a full service concession stand inside the facility.
- 14) No alcohol allowed in the dugouts. No alcohol allowed to be brought into the facility that was not purchased at the facility. Alcohol brought into the facility from outside is a liquor violation. Anyone caught will be prosecuted via the local police department.
- 15) We have a zero tolerance policy regarding fan and team behavior. Unruly fans or teams will be asked to leave the facility. If a fan, coach or player gets too far out of control they will be subject to arrest.
