THERE ARE BATTING CAGES AND PRACTICE INFIELDS OUTSIDE THE PLAYING FIELDS TO HIT AND TAKE INFIELD PRACTICE. GROUND BALLS ARE ALLOWED IN THE WARNING TRACK AREAS. THERE IS ALSO PLENTY OPEN SPACE FOR ALMOST ANY TYPE OF WARMING UP OUTSIDE THE PLAYING FIELDS. **NOTE 1:** 1 Pitch is considered an inning in all ages.

**NOTE 2:** In ages 9 – 12U a pitcher may not pitch on 3 consecutive days even if he has not exceeded the above listed limitations.

**NOTE 3:** In ages 9 – 14U, once a pitcher is removed from the pitching position, he may not re-enter as a pitcher for the remainder of the game

**VIOLATION PENALTY:** If a pitcher violates any of the above pitching limitations and a formal protest is filed with the tournament director the pitching logs will be checked to verify the alleged violation. If it is determined there is a violation: 1) the pitcher will be removed from the mound and not be allowed to pitch for the remainder of the tournament. 2) The coach will be ejected from the game and suspended for the next scheduled game. All innings pitched and runs scored up to the time the violation is discovered will be counted for both teams. This only applies if the protest is made when the violation is discovered while the game is in progress. If the violation is discovered after the completion of the game, the game results stand and no penalties imposed.

# Perfect Game Super 25 / 2017 Official Rules & By-Laws

## Rule 2.00

### Team and Individual Player Eligibility

**Team Eligibility:** Team's playing in any regional or super regional Qualifier must be sanctioned with Perfect Game. A player must participate in a qualifier event to be eligible to play in a National Championship. A player can play on only one National Championship team in the same bracket; however, a player can play in on additional team in an older age bracket if the younger team does not qualify for the National Championship. Players may play in an older age tournament.

**Rosters:** A team may not be composed of more than: Ages 9-12 seventeen (17) eligible players, Ages 13 & 14 twenty (20) eligible players, Ages 15-17 twenty-five (25) eligible players. Coaches or Managers are not included in the twenty five. Manager, coaches, business manager and scorekeeper may not exceed 4 total.

**Age Eligibility:** A player's age on April 30 of the season in play will dictate his age group for that season. Players can always play up in age brackets.

**Age Violation:** A player who is in violation of the age eligibility shall be considered an illegal player. Anytime during a tournament game, a player is discovered illegal due to an age violation or participating on more than one team in the same tournament, the offending player will be suspended from play for the remainder of the tournament in any age bracket. Upon the 2<sup>nd</sup> offense appropriate action up to and including suspension of offending team and coaches to further participation in future PG events may be taken.

**Identification:** In each age division, all participating players in PG events shall have photocopies of their original birth certificates in the possession of their team manager. Failure to have a copy of the birth certificates upon demand will result in the offending player being ejected from the game and suspended for the remainder of the event until such document can be produced. Driver's License is permitted.

**Player's Residence:** Teams must have 100% of their roster from their home area or regions or touching regions. When a team qualifies for a National Championship event, rosters must be the same as when they qualified in the region Tournament. Teams qualifying in the fall will have the ability to change their roster. 60% of the Fall roster must remain the same for National Championship in all age divisions, however they must play in a spring or summer area tournament with their corrected roster. They do not have to win the tournament once they have already qualified. Teams qualifying in the fall must play in a Qualifier, Regional or Super Regional tournament, spring or summer with their extended roster to be eligible for National Championship.

**Director:** A tournament Director may manage or coach in any tournament in which he also serves as the Tournament Director or host. There shall be a separate tournament director and protest committee selected to handle all rule problems within the tournament. The team's manager is responsible for all aspects of the eligibility of the players on his team and that they met the requirements as set forth in **Rule 2.02**.

## Rule 3.00

### Sanctioned Tournaments

Qualifiers, Regional, and Super Regional Tournaments events must consist of a minimum of four (4) games per team, schedule following the PG Super 25 tournament formats, weather permitting. Championship awards in all age brackets of Area play must be presented at completion of event. All qualifier winners receive berths to the current year's Regional Tournament. If a team has already won a Qualifier the 2<sup>nd</sup> place team down until a team accepts will be chosen. It will be the sole discretion of the Regional director as to the number of teams qualifying out of each area event. The maximum amount to be charged for a Qualifier, Regional, or Super Regional Tournament entry fee is \$750. Event host will provide (4) complimentary coach passes per team. All players will be admitted without charge.

**Tie-Breakers:** Tie Breaking procedure in all PG Super 25 tournament are as follows: Head-to-head (removed when any three or more teams are tied in pool play). Runs Allowed (1<sup>st</sup> criteria when any three or more teams are tied in pool play). Run differential. Average runs per inning in pool games. Coin flip

## Rule 4.00

### Ejection Rules

**Ejection Offenses:** Physical attack on an umpire, tournament official, associate director, and/or any player or fan prior, during or immediately following a game played under the authority of Perfect Game. Players, coaches, managers or sponsors threatening an umpire, tournament official, associate director, or associate officer with physical harm. Any player, coach, manager, sponsor, director, or officer who engages in physical fighting. Using unsportsmanlike conduct or abusive language, symbol tactics, or derogatory or unbecoming acts. Destruction of property or abuse or failure to pay. Receiving money directly or indirectly for playing on a team and or based on athletic performance. Competing under an assumed, false or altered name. Use of any illegal equipment, substance or falsification of any kind. The Tournament host has the authority to eject a player, fans or team anytime during a tournament of committing any of the above listed offenses.

**Ejection Penalty:** A player ejection carries removal from that game and the next game. A coach or manager ejection carries removal from that game only. Tobacco in any form is prohibited for players and coaches and is an ejection offense.

## Rule 5.00

### Playing field and equipment

The Official Baseball shall be supplied by tournament host and be of HS level quality. The official bat shall be constructed of wood or aluminum or any other material or combination of materials as approved by the National Federation of High Schools. In age brackets 9U-14U, there will be bat restrictions to BPF 1.15. In the 15U – 17U age brackets, bats may have no more than a minus 3 (-3) length to weight ratio. BBCOR. In events listed as "**Wood Bat**", only major league approved wood bats are allowed. Official uniforms must be complete with matching team jerseys with numbers that are non-duplicating. Only customary baseball shoes shall be work by any and all players. Regular metal cleats are allowed in all age brackets 13U – 17U. Catcher's requirements are the use of a catcher's mitt, chest protector, leg guards, protective cup, and catcher's helmet with face mask and throat guard. In 9U-14U, catchers must use hockey style mask in 15U -17U catchers may use a catcher's mask, plus a catcher's helmet. Offensive players are required to wear a double ear cover batter's helmet whenever at bat, on deck, base running, or base coaching.

## Rule 6.00

### Official Playing Rules

**Game Rules:** The official playing rules of PG Super 25 will follow Federations Rules with the exceptions being contained in this document. Game time limits and innings played shall adhere to the following chart: **Time starts at the time of the coin flip for home team.**

**Slide Rule:** Slide rule is in effect at all age level 9U – 17U. Any player is out when the runner does not slide when the defensive player has the ball and is waiting to make a tag. All players are required to avoid violent contact with another player while running the bases. Players running to 2B must slide directly into the base. If, in the opinion of the umpire, the runner does not make an effort to avoid collision, he is to be declared out. If the act is deemed by the umpire to be malicious, the runner will be ejected from the game.

**Courtesy Runners:** Courtesy runners may be used for the pitcher and catcher anytime in the inning in age divisions 9U-17U. The courtesy runner can only run once in the game inning and must be a player not in the line-up. If there are no substitute players, then no courtesy runner can be used. Once a player has been in the line-up (other than a runner) he is no longer eligible

**Batting Options:** An Extra Hitter (EH) batting ten is optional in all ages. A Designated hitter (DH) is optional also in all ages. Federation DH Rule will be used. Roster batting is also **optional**.

**Tied Games:** Games tied in pool play at the completion of game time limits shall be recorded as ties. If game time still exists there will be extra innings played. In bracket play tied games will be completed to determine a winner. No tie-breakers will be used. No bracket or championship games can end in a tie and will be completed or resumed until a winner is declared.

**Mercy Rule:** Run rules are in effect for all age levels. (15 after 3 inn. 10 after 4 inn. 8 after 5 inn.) The home team will not bat once the run rule has been acquired if ahead.

**Official Game:** A game affected by but not limited to the weather, run rule, light failure, darkness (on fields without lights) or time limits, shall be considered a complete game after five (5) complete innings or four and a half (4 ½) if the home team is ahead. For ages 9U-12U it will be 4 completed innings. Suspended games of a complete inning (1) will resume from the point of suspension. Games with less than one (1) inning will start over.

**Forfeits:** 15 minute grace period. If a team is unable to start with nine 9 players, the game will be recorded as a forfeit and the offended team will be awarded a 7-0 win.

**Pitching limitations:** When a pitcher is removed they may not return to the mound. Once a pitcher throws a pitch in an inning it will be constituted as an inning pitched.

**NOTE # 1:** **Pitching violations / Player & Manager ejection and suspended for next game.**

**NOTE # 2:** In all age brackets New Federation Rules about pitching do not apply

**Balks, etc.:** Balks, lead offs and dropped third strike will be in effect in all age divisions. **Slashing (fake bunt and swing)** is not allowed in the 9U-13U age divisions.

**Protests:** Protests of official playing rules must only be submitted to the tournament director with a \$100 cash protest fee. The official rules of protesting a game also must be adhered to for the protest to be considered. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned. Protests must be made at the time of the incident being protested. The protesting team must notify the umpire to inform the tournament director who upon notification will determine the outcome of the protest either at the field or through an agent acting on behalf of the director. The game continues until such time the director responds. Only rule violations, pitching limitations and roster issues may be protested. **UMPIRE JUDGEMENT CALLS ARE NOT A PROTEST ISSUE.**

**Intentional Walks:** In all age divisions, the batter is sent to first base with no pitches thrown.

**Conferences:** On the second charged conference in the same inning or a **third charged conference in a game** the pitcher must be removed. This applies for each new pitcher.

**Re-Entry:** Starters may re-enter the game one time, however they must re-enter in the same place in the batting order. Substitutes may not re-enter the game
